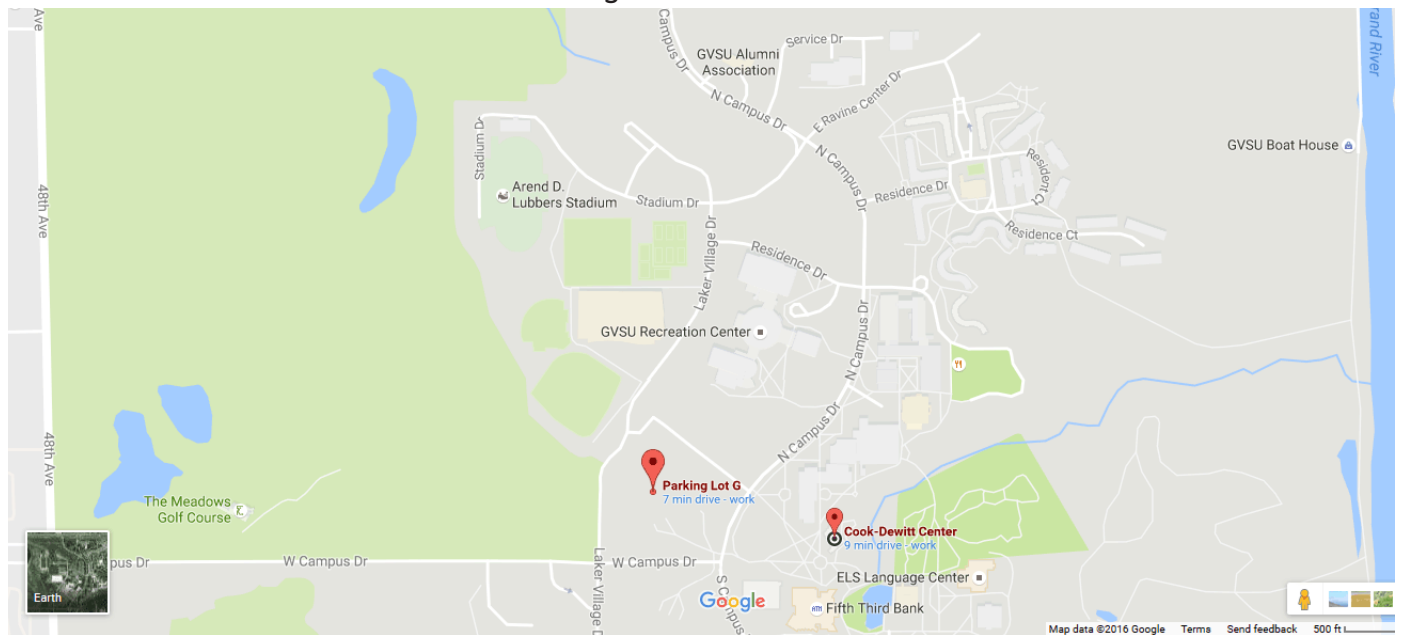

Sunday Mass times will remain as they are. For all of you who remember the ins & outs of set-up/tear downs at the Allendale Christian School, we're at it again,



moving out and moving in. So we will need teams of volunteers to assist in setting up before the 8 a.m. Mass and taking down after the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Students currently take care of those responsibilities for the 5:30 p.m. Mass, but we will need volunteers for the holidays when students are not here. Office operations will move to a temporary building at the new site. Other details, including transportation from the parking lot G to the Cook-DeWitt Center for those with mobility issues, location of daily Mass and the Dec. 8 holy day Masses (off campus location) are being worked on.

Since Christmas is on Sunday this year, there will be some variations on our historical holiday pattern and our Sunday schedule.

- Christmas Eve Masses will be at 4:30 p.m. and 10 p.m.
- Christmas Day Mass will be at 10 a.m. Mass.
- Dec. 31 (vigil for the Holy Day, Mary the Mother of God): Mass will be at 4:30 p.m.
- Jan. 1 there will be a Holy Day Mass at 10 a.m.
- NO Sunday evening Mass on Dec. 25 or Jan. 1

The regular Sunday Mass schedule will return, in Cook-DeWitt, for the Sundays of January.
