Before there was a St. Luke, but after I knew I was coming here I had a founding pastor fantasy that I might get to name the parish, and it would have been "Church of the Resurrection," simply because Christ rising from the dead is just that important.

Instead, I was doing R&R after Easter in 2007, in Palm Springs, and had just read the Easter reading of the Emmaus story from St. Luke's Gospel, and was checking my email when I saw the diocese had named our new parish: St. Luke University Parish.

I took it as a good sign that here I was, reflecting on the Resurrection, while being on vacation, and discovering on the day of St. Luke's Emmaus Story our parish would be named after St. Luke. He's one of the Evangelists - and his resurrection stories of Jesus, and all the Pentecost and Ascension tradition are spoken of in his writing.

As a Paulist, my clarity of St. Paul being an Evangelist helps me see the impact of Luke and the other Gospel writers as well. If you've gotten nothing out of your Paulist priests here about your responsibility to be evangelists yourselves, please recommit to doing so.

The central story of the Gospel is Christ risen from the dead. It changes everything. It is THE GOOD NEWS! In a year when we've brought a new church into being - a building from which to reach out to Western Michigan and the world - we also have to establish that Christ's Resurrection is THE EVENT that truly founded the CHURCH.

So here you are, a new church on your hands, the story of Christ in your heart, a Sunday of Alleluias in the music and on your lips, and a sharing of celebration with other Christians - you are immersed in the mystery of Easter! Being immersed, now you must climb out, of the font, of the cocoon, of the tomb, because a person who has been raised with Christ can no longer be contained, they must share the message they've experienced.

That's what we celebrate this Easter Sunday, and wherever the future paths we take will lead us, each of us has the responsibility to share the Story of Christ Risen from the Dead! Alleluia, Alleluia!
